Case Study | Professional Interviewing:Agents Expose Pharmaceutical Theft Ring

Challenge: A large New York distribution center that supplies pharmacies, hospitals and doctors with prescribed and over-the-counter medications noticed a gradual, yet substantial, shrinkage in their inventory. In a six month period, over half a million dollars of product had gone unaccounted and the client suspected facility employees were responsible for the losses.

Pinkerton's solution: Pinkerton placed three undercover operatives at the distribution center to monitor the situation. We conducted numerous interviews and coordinated several surveillance operations.

Results: Pinkerton identified 13 employees involved in the theft ring. Two arrests were made by the police department; the 11 remaining employees were terminated. Pinkerton then provided the client with recommendations to ensure tighter security and better inventory control to avoid future theft.
